B. TECHNICAL PROVISIONS

The competition is run according to rules given by the organizer in compliance with the military manual Vševojsk 4-2 “*Instructions on shooting handguns and combat vehicle mounted weapons*” with partly modified exercise rules and in compliance with the “*General Rules of Sports Shooting*” and “*Technical Rules of the Army Reserve Association of the Czech Republic*” pursuant to the provisions stipulated by other military regulations.

1. EVENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS

1.1 Site 1:

2. COMPETITION RULES

2.1 Competition

It is a shooting competition of **3-member teams** from reserve components, friendly countries and guests invited by the Chief of General Staff of the Czech Armed Forces or the organizer of the competition, shooting small arms introduced in the inventory of the Czech Armed Forces. The competition consists of 3 events – **CZ 75 SP-01 PHANTOM pistol and CZ 805 BREN assault rifle shooting.**

Each competitor has his/her own target and assigned small arm for all positions in one event. The team members are shooting simultaneously within a given time **without using the binoculars, optics and other non-standard accessories.** After the sighting and after finishing the event, the competitors will be allowed to look at the achieved results in the presence of the Fire Director or the Target Support Personnel.

The **Competition capacity** is 135 participants; each Active Reserve unit (from abroad) may apply with a maximum of **one team** (3 persons). The organizer reserves the right to adjust the capacity and to restrict participation in case of full capacity.

The team members are obliged to contribute to organizational tasks to ensure a smooth course of the Competition according to instructions provided by Competition Officials.

The Order of competing teams will be set during participants' registration based on the order of incoming competition applications. Guests and partners' shooting will not be included in the competition results.

2.2 General Instructions

Competitors who are not Czech MoD/Armed Forces personnel shall arrange for their insurance individually. During the Competition, medical service shall be provided by the Organizer.

Protests may be submitted to the Competition Director during the course of the Competition and **10 minutes after results publishing** only. The jury shall decide whether the protest is justified. Decisions made by the jury are binding for all the competitors.

All competition participants are obliged to follow instructions by Competition Officials throughout the Competition.

3. EVALUATION

Evaluation of the Competition will be in two categories: individuals and teams.

Placing of teams shall be determined by the total score all team members gained in the events. In case the total score of two teams is equal, a higher total score in the event No. 1.1 prevails.

1. If there is no decision, a higher score in the event No. 1.2 prevails. Individuals shall be evaluated separately for each event. In all events in case of equal score, higher quantity of scored 10s, 9s, 8s (...) hits prevails. The best 15 shots count into the score, including results of the sighting.

If the team is incomplete, its members compete as individuals.

3.1 Individuals – placing in individual events:

- **Event 1.1** – 1st to 3rd place: gift, medal and certificate
- **Event 1.2** – 1st to 3rd place: gift, medal and certificate
- **Event 1.3** – 1st to 3rd place: gift, medal and certificate

3.2 Teams – overall placing:

- **The Cup of the Chief of General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Czech Republic will be awarded to the best placed Czech Armed Forces Active Reserve team**
- **1st to 3rd place** – gift for each team member, medal and certificate

4. ORGANIZATIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

The organizer provides both weapons and ammunition for the Competition; the use of own weapons and ammunition is forbidden.

4.1 Dress code for service personnel:

Field uniform and cap with visor. During shooting, it is **mandatory** to wear ear and eye protection gear provided by the organizer.

4.2 Accommodation:

For the competition **participants**, accommodation is arranged in double rooms in the **Youth Home** (*Domov mládeže*), Koterovská 85, Plzeň-Lobzy (**49°44'1.279''N; 13°24'12.189''E**), the Czech Republic. In accordance with Paragraph 21 of the Act No. 45/2016 Coll., Active Reserve of the Czech Armed Forces personnel will be provided accommodation at this location free of charge.

Foreign competitors will ask for a receipt of payment individually. The payment needs to be made in CZK. The price is 300 CZK (approximately EUR 11.50) per person per night. All guests of the Youth Home must abide by the instructions of the lodging providers available at the reception of the Youth Home and the rules of the Youth Home. In case of any damage caused to the property, financial compensation will be claimed.

4.3 Board:

Meals will be provided free of charge during the competition to the members of the Active Reserve Component of the Armed Forces of the Czech Republic ordered to the Regular Military Training Exercise and to the Military Professionals deployed to the Competition based on the request of the Director of RMHQ Pilsen.

4.4 Place and time of arrival and registration:

4.4.1. Place of commencement and termination of the Regular Military Training Exercise (members of the Czech Active Reserve Component)

Not applicable for international competitors.

4.4.2. Place and time of the registration of international competitors and organizers

Army Shooting Range Dukla Pilsen-Lobzy (49,736635N;13,41893E), (N49°44,198'; E13°25,135') in Lobzy, Pilsen, the administrative building to the left from the main entrance into the compound of Army Shooting Range Lobzy, arrival and registration **from 16:00 hours until 20:00 hours on 2 October 2026**.

4.5 Transport and parking:

4.5.1. Competitors – members of the Czech Active Reserve Component

Not applicable for international competitors.

4.5.2. Competitors – participants from foreign countries

Participants shall arrive to the venue of registration by their own means of transport or by public transport.

Parking in the Army Shooting Range area is available. The organizer arranges for shuttle bus service from the lodging facility to the venue of the Competition and back (timetable will be presented to participants upon registration).

The use of private vehicles in the Shooting Range area (except the parking lot) **is prohibited**.

4.5.3 – Caution for the members of the Czech Active Reserve Component

Not applicable for international competitors.

5. SAFETY RULES:

All participants are obliged to comply with the safety measures as stipulated in the Vševojsk 2-9 and Vševojsk 4-2 military manuals, strictly adhere to the “Range Operating Procedures”, attend the instruction sessions where the above mentioned are to be presented and after that to sign a document confirming that they understood the safety briefing.

All shooters are obliged to follow the instructions by the Fire Directors of the sites, with an emphasis on safe operating of the weapons and observance of the Safety Rules. Weapons are to be handled only on the Fire Director’s order; the arm is to be pointed into the designated firing sector only. It is prohibited to point the arm rearward or off the firing sector. If there is a gun failure and the shooter is not able to fix it within the time allowed for firing, he/she raises a hand to notify the Fire Director who will then take necessary measures.

While shooting, all shooters are required to use ear protection gear and protective glasses. **It is strictly forbidden to consume alcoholic beverages, chemical substances affecting concentration or any other addictive substances throughout the competition**, as defined in the Range Operating Procedures.

All competitors are required to comply with a random Breathalyzer test if asked. Failure to comply can lead to disqualification.

The organizer shall not be held responsible for any damage to the participant’s personal belongings or injury.

Should the competitor break the Safety Rules, he/she will be disqualified.

C. FINAL PROVISIONS:

All participants are obliged to follow the present **Competition Rules and Instructions**.

All participants are obliged to strictly follow the **Range Operating Procedures**, Safety Measures when shooting and at the Shooting Range; the participation is at their own risk and they are responsible for any damage or injury they may cause.

The organizer reserves the right to make **changes** and **amendments** to the present competition rules and instructions.

D. APPLICATION AND POCs:

The application will be submitted by the person responsible for the training of Reserve Components of a given Unit. The application is available online at <https://kvv-plzen.mo.gov.cz/aktivni-zaloha/strelecka-soutez-aktivnich-zaloh-o-pohar-ngs-acr>. The application is to be submitted no later than **August 4, 2026**. By submitting the application, the competitor agrees with the use of his/her personal data.
